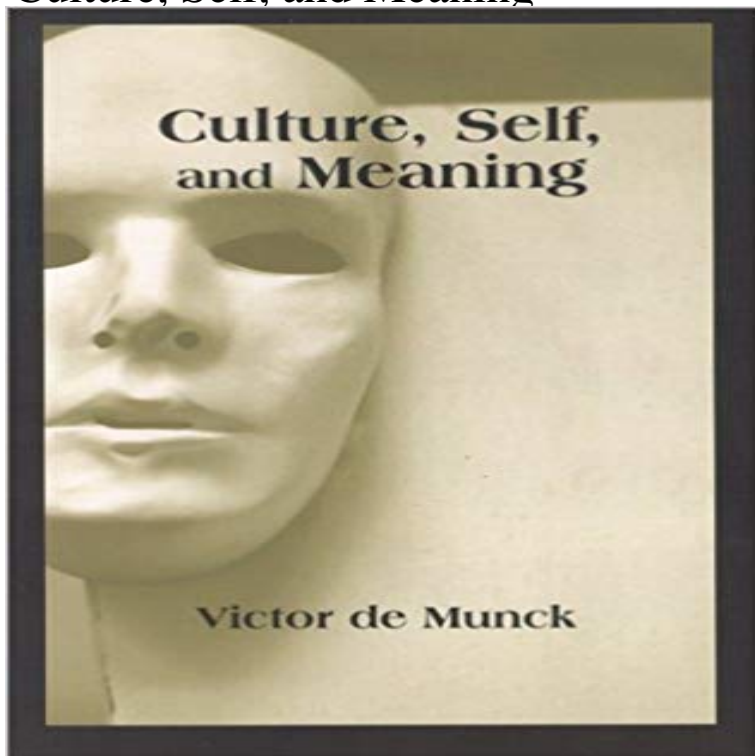


Culture, Self, and Meaning
