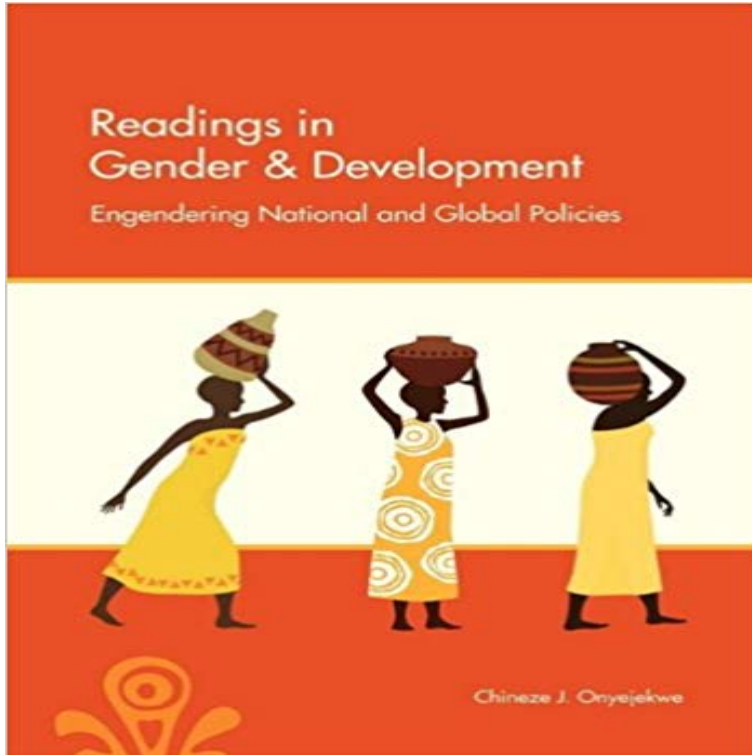


Readings in Gender and Development: Engendering National and Global Policies

Dr. Onyejekwe has also written extensively on various aspects of gender and development issues-with a special focus on women in the Global South.
