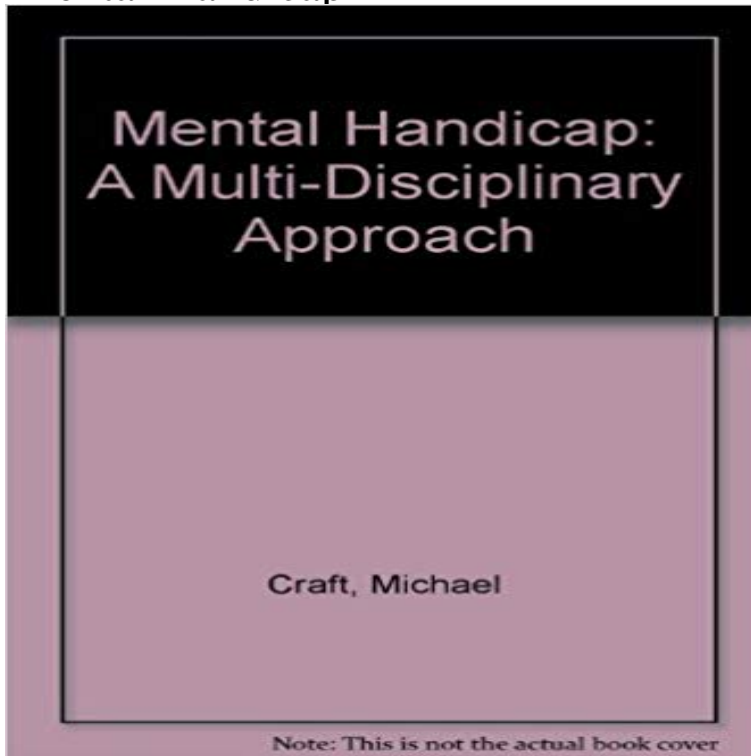


Mental Handicap
