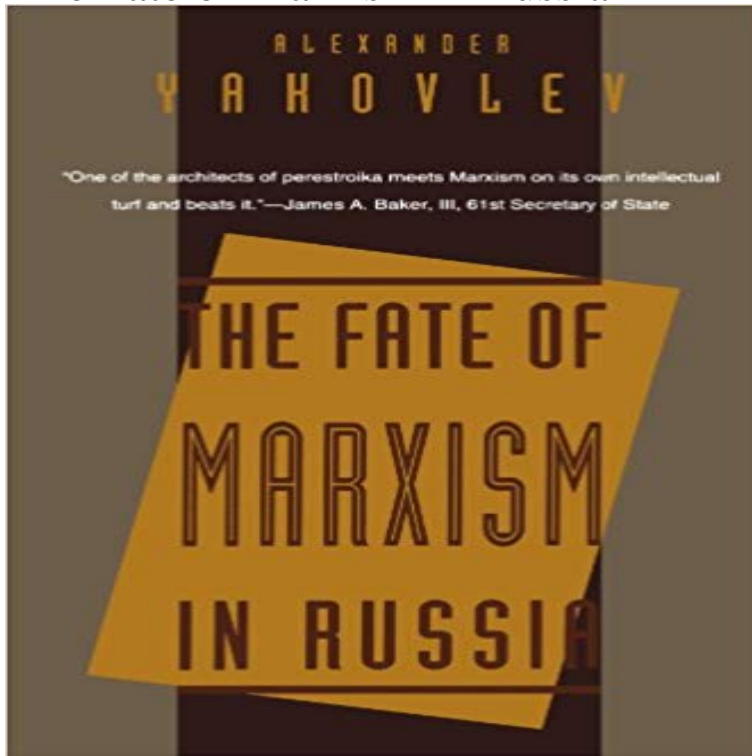


The Fate of Marxism in Russia
